PDL International Pte Ltd are pleased to announce an improvement to our frequency of service between NZ and the Cook Islands.

The Tiare Moana will be withdrawn from the trade at the conclusion of Voyage 49 and the continuation of PDL's service to the Cook Islands will be provided by Auckland and Tauranga loading on the Liloa and the Imua II, a larger vessel which will be replacing the Olomana from April. This will ensure that PDL space requirements for our valued Cook Island customers are protected.

Our agency company, Transam Cook Islands, will be the husbandry agent for the Liloa & as part of an improved service, both these vessels will also be calling Aitutaki.

Offering this revised service, our customers will benefit from a sailing every 14 days and a call into Rarotonga & Aitutaki every fourteen days as per below schedule.
