

Delays to Southern Pearl V185 through Fiji

Dear Valued Customers,

Due to the unavailability of compliant bunker fuel in Suva, Southern Pearl had to receive fuel in Lautoka on which was delivered by tanker trucks, a much slower operation than loading bunker with the pipeline in Suva. This resulted in half a day lost on her schedule for this voyage.

Furthermore, a tropical depression has been building North West of the Fiji Islands and has now been classed as category 1 Tropical Cyclone Sarai. The deteriorating weather conditions have necessitated the stoppage of cargo operations in Suva and the Southern Pearl to vacate her berth immediately and take shelter until safer conditions prevail.

We will update her forward schedule as soon as possible.
