

Terminal Handling Charge (THC) - Fiji

Dear Valued Customers,

Fiji Ports Terminal Limited (FPTL) announced on the 11th August 2015 that from the 24th August 2015, the wharfage, stevedoring and berthage rates would be increased in both Suva and Lautoka ports.

The level of increases, which directly affect our operating costs, necessitate a review of our Terminal Handling Charge (THC) that is charged on all imports and exports to & from Suva and Lautoka.

From the following voyages,

Capitaine Wallis v40 eta Suva on the 4th September 2015
Southern Moana V275 eta Lautoka on the 05th September 2015
Forum Pacific v146 eta Lautoka on the 6th September 2015
Southern Pearl V107 eta Suva on the 11th September 2015
Southern Phoenix V120 eta Suva on the 24th September 2015

the THC will be increased to the below amounts :

Dry Cargo : FJD 497/per teu
Reefer Cargo : FJD 557/per teu
Break Bulk : FJD 15.60/per revenue tonne

We apologise for the short notice regarding this increase however the new rate levels charged by FPTL are already in practice.
