

Weather delays – Tropical Cyclone Keni

Dear Valued Customers,

The tropical depression which was developing in the northern Vanuatu region late last week, was classed as Tropical Cyclone Keni on Monday.

M/V Southern Moana, having completed her operations in Santo on the Sunday, had to shelter in Santo until conditions improved. She finally sailed Tuesday morning and is now late on schedule, due in Tauranga on the 15th and Auckland on the 16th of April.

M/V Southern Pearl arrived Monday morning in Lautoka, but had to vacate the berth and sail away from the path of the incoming TC Keni. She has returned to berth at Lautoka this morning to commence cargo operations and her eta to Suva is delayed until Thursday 12th April.

These delays to schedule will be reflected in our weekly schedule update which will be distributed later today.
