

**Weather delays to Forum Pacific V173N – Apia cargo**

Dear Valued Customers,

Following our notice yesterday regarding the weather conditions affecting the Forum Pacific V173 and her deviation to Pago Pago, we are now able to confirm the following amendments to her schedule.

Forum Pacific has now sailed from Pago Pago after having completed her operations there. The conditions in Apia are still unsafe for her to return and berth & so she has adjusted her course for the port of Nuku'alofa in Tonga.

All the Apia cargo on board the Forum Pacific V173 will be discharged in Nuku'alofa on Monday and loaded on the Southern Lily V422, which will also be working in Nuku'alofa on Monday. The Apia cargo will then be delivered on the Southern Lily V422, eta Apia on the 15<sup>th</sup> February.
