Dear Valued Customers,

Further to our notice regarding category 5 tropical cyclone Harold expected to pass through the region, from Tuesday 07th April at 1200hrs the ports of Suva & Lautoka will cease all operations and both ports will be closed by 1700hrs this until the cyclone has passed.

As a result and in order to retain schedule, the Capitaine Tasman which has already completed Suva operations will omit the direct port call of Lautoka and instead head southbound back to Tauranga where she will pick up her scheduled position to commence V26 in Tauranga on the 10th April.

The Capitaine Tasman v25 Lautoka import and export cargo plan is as follows;

1. Lautoka imports currently booked on v025 will stay on board and be discharged on voyage 026N.
2. Lautoka export cargo booked for Capitaine Tasman V25S, will now be loaded on the Capitaine Dampier V158S
