

Lautoka Port Closure from 23rd March until 02nd April

24th March 2020

Dear Valued Customers,

The Port of Lautoka has been shut by authorities for a period of at least 10 days as a policy related to control the spread of Covid-19. As such all cargo ships below will have to discharge Lautoka cargo at Suva:

Capitaine Dampier V158
Southern Moana V021
Southern Pearl V189
Capitaine Wallis V348
Kota Hakim V428

This means all import cargo destined to Lautoka will be delivered to Suva during this period. Lautoka customers will need to collect their cargo from Suva. All additional costs will be for the importers account.

All export cargo booked from Lautoka will need to be delivered to Suva by the exporters to meet vessels that are unable to call Lautoka during this period. All additional costs will be for the exporters account.

We will keep you informed as the situation develops. We will circulate a revised sailing schedule later today. Please contact our local representative Transam Fiji Agencies for any further information.
